

FIELD TRIP LEADERSHIP PROGRAM IN SAN FRANCISCO

Leading field trips is a very rewarding experience! In this unique, interactive course, Eddie Bartley will discuss the fundamentals of leading a successful field trip with a focus on using stories about the natural history of the San Francisco Bay Area to entertain and educate trip participants.

The program consists of an evening presentation in San Francisco on Thursday, February 4, 7 to 9 p.m., followed by a field trip on Sunday, February 7, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., to many of the birdy and natural areas of San Francisco. At each stop on the field trip, we will provide information on the natural features and past and current conservation issues while observing and listing the fauna we encounter.
